In the coming issues we'll share news, deadlines, events, and wisdom from our past scholarship winners about their college experience.



Calling all Business Majors: Scholarship Window is Open!

Since 2006, the foundation has awarded 135 scholarships, totaling \$2.6M, to Middle Tennessee students. This is a need- and merit-based renewable scholarship. Last year, the average award was \$7,700 (per year) and 20 scholarships were awarded. There is no limit to the number of awards, it's simply based on the quality of the applicants.

- 1. Start your search early.** Build a profile on a scholarship search site. Ask your guidance counselor for a list of local scholarships.
- 2. Luck is not a strategy.** Be sure you meet all qualifications before applying; this saves time.
- 3. Gather documents and recommendations early.** Respect the time of others.

Upcoming Fall Deadlines

ACT - Register by November 8 for the December 14 test.

SAT - Register by November 8 for December 7 test.

FASFA - January 1st is the first day you can begin your application.
