

Our Largest Scholarship Class to Date!

The Foundation Awards this Class \$2.8M over 4 Years

For the second consecutive year we have received a record number of applications and awarded a record number of scholarships. The total number of Scarlett Scholars awarded since 2006 now exceeds 400 students from Middle Tennessee.

Our newest Scarlett Scholars are from 20 counties across Middle Tennessee representing public, independent, and home schools. This fall, our recipients will attend 53 universities in 14 states, and 25% of them are already enrolled. This class is pursuing a wide range of business and STEM related bachelors degrees, ranging from meteorology to marketing, nuclear engineering to nursing, chemistry to communications, and many others.

It's Official! Tuition-Free Community College for all Tennessee Adults

Governor Haslam's proposal to expand Tennessee Promise to include any adult Tennessee resident without a college degree or certificate passed on April 13th and will be available in the fall of 2018. This new program is called Tennessee Reconnect.

Around 900,000 Tennesseans have some college credit but no degree. Adults who have never attended college will now be eligible, and the program will be open to an estimated 2 million Tennesseans.
