DATA SUMMARY

The Hunters Lane cluster has one Reward school, but ties Maplewood for the second highest number of Priority schools with four. With three of the lowest performing elementary and middle schools, hundreds of students will attend both elementary and middle schools ranked in the state's bottom five percent.

The high school ranks near the bottom for every metric, with only one in ten students meeting the state Ready Graduate standard. More than one-third of Hunters Lane high school students are chronically absent.

Priority School

The state of Tennessee identifies a Ready Graduate as a student who graduated on time in 2017 and earned a composite ACT score of a 21 or higher, the score at which students are considered career and college ready.
