DATA SUMMARY

The Pearl Cohn cluster is the only one with more non-zoned than zoned schools, and student achievement varies widely. Students attending zoned schools have the second-lowest achievement numbers in the district, with 15% or less scoring "on track" or "mastered". No zoned school meets the state average for student achievement. By contrast, half of the cluster's ten non-zoned schools earned Reward school status.

Chronic absenteeism grows as students advance through grade levels, progressing from 24% in elementary and 27% in middle to almost 40% in high school. In the high school, less than 10% are considered college or career ready. Pearl Cohn serves the highest percentage of economically disadvantaged students of all the clusters, with almost eight in ten students qualifying.

KEY

- Reward School Identified by the state as improving student achievement and growth. The top distinction a school can earn in TN.
- Priority School Identified by the state and fall in the bottom five percent statewide over the past three years, and are in need of the most support and improvement.
- % Ready Graduate** The state of Tennessee identifies a Ready Graduate as a student who graduated on time in 2017 and earned a composite ACT score of a 21 or higher, the score at which students are considered career and college ready. Students missing 10% of schools days or 18 days
- Chronic Absenteeism** % for English and Math represent the number of students scoring "on track" or "mastered." Schools that fell below the TN state average (33% for both subjects) are in red and those exceeding the state average are in green.
- English & Math:** < 33% > 33%
- NA Data not available. When the percentage of students is below 5%, or above 95%, the state suppresses the data because it could be identifiable for students. We can understand that the percentage of students "on track or mastered" is below 5 percent and therefore unavailable.
